Dear Sixth Grade Virtual Students and Families,

Welcome to Sixth Grade! We are so excited that you have decided to continue your education virtually at SJRS. This document contains information about your virtual classroom and expectations for participation. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me.

Daily Attendance: Attendance will be taken through Google Classroom. The Check-in form must be completed daily and will be used as the attendance tracker. If the Check-in is not completed for that day, the student will be marked absent.

Materials: You will be given all books and workbooks in order to complete the 6th grade assignments. Check the stationery list on the website to ensure you have the correct number of copybooks. Please cover workbooks with contact paper. All books and workbooks are numbered and students need to be accountable for materials. If at some point your student transitions back to in person learning, all resources must be returned to school.

Google Classroom: It is important that you check Google Classroom daily. Daily announcements and assignments will be

posted. In addition to taped lessons there may be written assignments, homework, videos, or other websites to support our virtual learning. Goggle Classroom may contain worksheets, documents, or tests to complete. You have 48 hours in order to complete assignments and tests. If work is late, students will lose 5 points per day. It is expected that students should complete tests independently. Tests may be in the form of paper and pencil or Google Classroom.

Subjects: The subject areas for Mrs. Williams include Religion, Math, Social Studies, and Language Arts. As part of our religion class, the workbook is utilized as well as notes. Notes may be in the form of power point or paper/pencil. Students are expected to recopy notes into copybooks and study daily. Weekly masses are on Friday. Math lessons include written assignments which will need to be submitted for completion and accuracy. A math maintenance worksheet will be assigned every Monday with a due date of Friday. Daily social studies includes reading from the textbook as well as typed notes. Students may also need to complete definitions as needed. Many lessons are accompanied by videos which may have an attached Google Classroom worksheet. Language Arts includes Spelling and English grammar. Pages from spelling are completed every day. Writing the weekly words 5 times each is assigned on a Friday with the due date the following Tuesday. English includes daily written assignments as well as copying notes and examples into copybooks. There will be

sentence diagramming that is also included in assignments and tests.

Option C: Grades will be posted on the Option C website.

Students and parents are encouraged to check the site frequently to stay updated with assignment completions.

Communication: If you have a question about an assignment, please email me. I may not be able to respond during the school day but will make every effort to get back to you in a reasonable time.
