

Dear Kindergarten Virtual Students and Families,

Welcome to Kindergarten! We are so excited that you have decided to continue your education virtually at SJRS. This flyer will provide you with information about your virtual classroom and expectations for participation. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

Google Classroom: Daily announcements and assignments (classwork, homework) will be posted on Google Classroom. We will be using other websites to support virtual learning (Dreambox & Stemscores). The directions when using Dreambox and Stemscores will be posted on Google Classroom. We also will be utilizing workbooks, worksheets, videos and at times other resources. If additional worksheets are assigned, they will be posted on Google Classroom for you to print. If you are not able to print out worksheets, an alternative assignment will be given.

Supplies: You will be given a Religion Book with a Children's Bible, Reading Book, Reader's Notebook, a Writing Journal and a Math Book. We will also send home a set of math manipulatives, a wipe off board, small chalk board and all the supplies purchased with the stationery fee (crayons, glue, scissors, wipe off marker, paints, playdough). If at any time your child transitions back to in person learning, all supplies, books, and resources need to be returned to school.

Daily Attendance: Daily attendance will be taken through Google Classroom. The Check-in form must be completed daily and will be used as the attendance tracker. If Check-in is not completed for that day, your child will be marked absent. Please refer to the information that is posted on the SJRS website (SJRS Remote Learning Summary, Q&A and Responsibilities Sheet 8-17-20).

Office hours: If you have a question about an assignment, please email me and we will respond by the end of the school day or shortly after dismissal. We do not always have time to check my emails once the school day starts. You may also call the school office and leave a message for us if it is something that we need to know before the end of the day.

Assessment: Since Kindergarten students do not receive grades on Progress Reports and Report Cards individual assessments are used to evaluate comprehension of skills. Completed daily assignments on google classroom and individual zoom meetings will be used to assess your child's progress.
